

What is it?

A process for faculty members of varying disciplines and levels of experience to learn from each other through observation & discussion.

It is NOT evaluative or judgmental.

How does it work?

1. Faculty form small, diverse groups & set up expectations.
2. Group members independently observe each other teach one class.
3. Members write about their observations & reflections.
4. Group meets to share and discuss observations and ideas.
