## Lund Maritime Scholarship Information

The Lund Scholarship Foundation provides Ketchikan graduates funding for maritime classroom training and education.

Following is info for applying to the Lund Foundation for the scholarship:

- Available to Kayhi or Revilla graduates, and to Ketchikan GED graduates that have gone through the Ketchikan school system prior to dropping out of school. Must be a Ketchikan Resident.
- Provides tuition assistance for maritime education.
- Applications must be submitted for approval **prior** to taking the class. The Foundation **does not** provide money for classes that are not pre-approved. Generally, students must pay for the class up front and will be reimbursed upon completion of the class.
- Application consists of writing a letter outlining:
  - Your current status
  - Your maritime career goals
  - What you are currently doing to meet those goals
